#### Christmas Fair

The Christmas Fair will take place on Friday 5th December. The arrangements for this year are as follows. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and their siblings can be collected via the main entrance from 2pm. At 2.30pm Years 3,4,5 and 6 will visit the fair. Parents are welcome to join their children at this time. No child in Key Stage 2 will be allowed to leave school before normal finishing time at 3.15pm unless they have been collected by an adult. Each class will be making arts/crafts to sell as well as refreshments being available. Children's calendars will be available to order. We will be holding a Christmas raffle, tickets will be sent home some soon. Other stalls will include a children's chocolate tombola, tombola, face painting and Santa's Grotto. We are starting to collect prizes and would welcome any donations or unwanted gifts into school.
